



# Building Science Technician

This position is considered an entry-level Part-Time position and is anticipated to provide 15 to 30 hours per week.

## Core Tasks/Expectations

- Field work (90%)
  - Perform multiple building science and performance tests, including but not limited to blower door testing, duct leakage testing, ventilation testing, infrared camera scan, air flow measurements, etc.
  - Perform basic level energy audits for existing homes which includes blower door testing, thermal imaging and a visual non-intrusive assessment for energy efficiency opportunities, potential safety considerations and durability issues
- Office work (10%)
  - Prepare punctual reports that communicate effectively to both home builders and home owners.
  - Meet and communicate with both home owners and home builders, in an educated, confident manner regarding building science related recommendations and analyses

- Demonstrate a high level of organization, detail-oriented, self-directed, efficient multi-tasking and flexible
- Willingness to learn and perform new tasks and duties
- High level of oral and written communication skills
